WHEREAS, according to the 2023 Homeless Point in Time Count, 4,244 individuals were experiencing homelessness across Dallas and Collin County, and, of that number, 28 percent were unsheltered; and

WHEREAS, local shelters and other community organizations provide meals, housing, clothing, and a myriad of other services to help individuals and families exit homelessness; and

WHEREAS, over the past year, Catholic Charities Dallas has delivered over 8 million meals through their five mobile food pantries and two client choice pantries; and

WHEREAS, public education on the plight of Dallas residents living without a home and access to quality, nutritious food is critically important, particularly as we approach the holiday season.
