**PRESS RELEASE: Barry Wernick Declares Candidacy for Texas House District 108**

DALLAS, TEXAS – Barry Wernick has declared his run to become the Republican representative for the people of the newly redrawn Texas House District 108 which includes, the Park Cities, Uptown, Downtown, Bluffview, Preston Hollow, Northwood Hills, Lakewood, Lake Highlands, and all the best neighborhoods in Dallas in-between. Wernick is taking on long-term incumbent, Morgan Meyer.

And that's one of the main reasons why voters from all over the district are fired up to have a choice in the Republican primary on March 5th. I look forward to meeting the voters and candidly addressing the facts."

Wernick grew up in the Preston Hollow neighborhood of Dallas. His brothers and he were raised by a strong single mother after their father abandoned the family. She made it clear to her four boys that they were not victims. And neither was she. As a single mother with no child support, she led by example, and through hard work and determination, it paid off. She instilled in her children the importance of education, as well as the love for God, country, state, city, and our community. These are the principles that Wernick stands by to this day. As a practicing Orthodox Jew who is active in his synagogues and community, he is strong in his Jewish faith. Barry is a husband to Alyssa and a father to three young girls.
