DISCLAIMER: This report provides a snapshot of the Fort Worth Police Department's National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) data that was queried from the Records Management System (RMS) on October 10, 2023. The Department's RMS is updated regularly due to ongoing investigations. Since this is a snapshot, data queried before or after this date could change and may vary from other reports.

Understanding Crime Reporting

Fort Worth has utilized the National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) methodology for crime reports since 2006. NIBRS compiles detailed reports on two types of crime offenses: Group A offenses and Group B offenses. The groupings are based on the amount of reporting required for each. Both incidents and arrests are reported for Group A offenses. To learn more about the differences between NIBRS and the Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR), the formerly used Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) methodology, please visit https://www.fbi.gov/services/cjis/ucr/nibrs.

The following criteria is used to determine whether a crime should be designated as a Group A offense:

- 1. The seriousness or significance of the offense.
- 2. The frequency or volume of its occurrence.
- 3. The prevalence of the offense nationwide.
- 4. The probability of the offense being brought to law enforcement's attention.
- 5. The likelihood that law enforcement is the best channel for collecting data regarding the offense.
- 6. The burden placed on law enforcement in collecting data on the offense.
- 7. The national statistical validity and usefulness of the collected data.
- 8. The national UCR Program's responsibility to make crime data available not only to law enforcement but to others having a legitimate interest in it.

Group A offenses are categorized into one of three categories: 1) Crimes Against Persons, 2) Crimes Against Property, and 3) Crimes Against Society.

- 1) Crimes Against Persons = Scores one offense for each victim
- 2) Crimes Against Property = Scores one offense for each distinct operation (except Motor Vehicle Theft / one offense is counted per stolen vehicle)
- 3) Crimes Against Society = Scores one offense for each violation

2023 3rd Quarter Crime Report

Citywide Group A crime increased 0.1% in the Third Quarter of 2023 compared to the Third Quarter of 2022. Crimes Against Persons increased 1.5% with 3,923 offenses reported in the Third Quarter, compared to 3,865 offenses in the Third Quarter of 2022. Crimes Against Property decreased 0.2% with 8,788 offenses reported in the Third Quarter compared to 8,803 in the Third Quarter of 2022. Crimes Against Society decreased 3.0% with 1,151 offenses compared to 1,187 in 2022.




Yearly Comparison

Crime Prevention Strategies

Commanders in each patrol division take preventative steps to address any increase in crime such as aggravated assaults, burglaries and motor vehicle thefts. All patrol divisions have strategic operating funds (SOF) used to address crime in their areas. Commanders work with the Real Time Crime Center, Crime Analysts, and Neighborhood Police Officers to identify emerging trends and hotspot areas. Commanders keep track of previous crime trends and put officers in those locations to prevent crime from occurring. There is constant collaboration with other units within the department including Gang, Narcotics, Vice, Homicide, Robbery, and Family Violence in an effort to reduce and solve crime.

Chief Neil Noakes introduced the <u>#FortWorthSafe</u> strategy in 2021 and it continues into 2023. The crime reduction strategy focuses on violent crimes such as homicide, robbery, shootings and aggravated assault. Below are the strategy's Goals and Objectives:

- 1. Decrease overall violent crime in the city by 10% in the next 12 months.
- 2. Focus on decreasing homicides, aggravated assaults and robberies.
- 3. Improve neighborhood conditions in areas experiencing most violent crime.
- 4. Improve police-community relations and communication.

2023 3rd Quarter - Crimes Against Persons

Crimes Against Persons increased 1.5% overall in the Third Quarter of 2023 compared to the Third Quarter of 2022. There were decreases in human trafficking, murder, and nonnegligent manslaughter. There was an increase in forcible rape.

Murder & Nonnegligent Manslaughter and Negligent Manslaughter Quarterly Stats



In the Third Quarter of 2023, homicide offenses **decreased** 15.6% with 27 homicide victims compared to 32 in the Third Quarter of 2022.



Eight of the 27 incidents had an unknown motive, five incidents were robberies, (four of the five robberies were narcotics related), five incidents were arguments/fights, three were domestic, three were gang related, one was reckless/negligence, one had an other motive, and one was random. The three gang related homicides were a triple homicide.



Twenty of the 27 homicides have been filed. Suspects have been identified in 22 of the offenses.



Six homicides occurred in Council District 11, four in Council District 3, three each in Council Districts 5, 6, and 9. Two each in Council Districts 2, 4, and 8, and one each in Council Districts 7 and 10.




20 of the 27 homicides were by a firearm.

Homicide Prevention Strategies

FWPD's homicide prevention strategies involve various partnerships. Neighborhood Police Officers, the Victim Assistance Section, and One Safe Place provide outreach services to prevent domestic violence crimes that have the potential to turn into a homicide. In addition, the Homicide Unit works closely with the Crime Lab as policies have changed allowing for more timely entry of ballistic intelligence into the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearm's (ATF) National Integrated Ballistic Information Network (NIBIN) to more readily identify persons who may be involved in violent offenses. The Homicide Unit also continues to work with members of the Gang, Narcotics, and Robbery Units where other criminal activity may elevate to homicide.

Assault Offenses



- Approximately 32% were known to be domestic-related.
- 49% occurred within a residence, 28% on a highway, road, or in an alley, 9% in parking lot/garage, and 1% in a bar/nightclub.

Simple Assaults

Aggravated Assault

- Approximately 62% were known to be domestic-related.
- 62% occurred within a residence, 10% on a highway, road, or in an alley, 6% in a parking lot/garage, and 2% in a bar/nightclub.

Aggravated Assault

An unlawful attack by a person upon another person where the offender uses or displays a weapon in a threatening manner, or the victim suffers obvious severe or aggravated bodily injury.

Simple Assaults

An unlawful physical attack by one person upon another where neither the offender displays a weapon, nor the victim suffers obvious severe or aggravated bodily injury.

Intimidation

To unlawfully place another person in reasonable fear of bodily harm through the use of threatening words and/or other conduct, but without displaying a weapon or an actual physical attack.

Kidnapping/Abduction

There were 58 kidnapping/abduction offenses in the Third Quarter of 2023 compared to 54 offenses in the Third Quarter of 2022, which is a 7.4% increase.

Of the 58 kidnapping offenses this quarter, 48 were unlawful restraints, 8 were aggravated kidnappings, and 2 were kidnappings.

Please refer to Texas Penal Code Title 5, Chapter 20 for full definitions, below are abbreviated definitions of each:

- Unlawful restraint: Intentionally or knowingly [restraining] another person.
- Kidnapping: Intentionally or knowingly [abducting] another person ... not coupled with intent to use or to threaten to use deadly force.
- Aggravated Kidnapping: Intentionally knowingly [abducting] another person with the intent [for example] to hold him for ransom or reward ... use him as a shield or hostage...inflict bodily injury.
- Unlawful Transport: For pecuniary benefit [transporting] an individual in a manner that is designed to conceal the individual from ... law enforcement authorities ... and [creating] a substantial likelihood that the individual will suffer serious bodily injury or death.

Sex Offenses

172 offenses Forcible Rape

Forcible Rape offenses increased 32.3% from 130 offenses in the Third Quarter of 2022 to 172 offenses in the Third Quarter of 2023.

- In approximately 67% of cases, victim knew suspect.
- Approximately 62% of all victims were 17 years of age or under.

103 offenses Forcible, Other

Other Forcible sex offenses decreased 16.3% from 123 offenses in the Third Quarter of 2022 to 103 offenses in the Third Quarter of 2023.


- Approximately 89% of all victims were 17 years of age or under.
- Includes sodomy, sexual assault with an object, and forcible fondling.

0 offenses Non-forcible

Non-forcible sex offenses decreased from one offense in the Third Quarter of 2022 to zero in the Third Quarter of 2023.

The Sex Crimes Unit continues the investigative process with the goal of bringing all perpetrators to justice.

Special Victims Section



- Number of cases assigned to the Crimes Against Children Unit increased 10%.
- Number of cases assigned to the Domestic Violence Unit increased 6.7%.
- Number of cases assigned to the Sex Crimes Unit increased 0.9%.

Crimes Against Children Unit

The Crimes Against Children Unit investigates and is assigned incidents of abuse and sexual abuse of children under 17 & homicides of children under the age of six.

Domestic Violence Unit

The Domestic Violence Unit investigates and is assigned incidents of domestic violence in partnership with the various, collocated agencies in the One Safe Place umbrella (Tarrant County's Family Justice Center).

Sex Crimes Unit


The Sex Crimes Unit investigates and is assigned incidents of sexual assault, indecent exposures, public lewdness, improper photography, injury to the elderly in care facilities, stalking, and any other crime of a sexual nature involving adults 17 years old and older.

Special Victims Support

The Sex Crimes Unit and the Victim Assistance Section work with patrol officers, hold community meetings, and provide presentations to local colleges on ways to prevent sexual assault. The Sex Crimes Unit along with TCU officials conduct information-exchange meetings to encourage discussion on ways to reduce the likelihood of becoming a victim. The Victim Assistance Section continues to provide support services to victims of reported sexual assaults. Cold Case Sexual Assault Detectives have been successful in solving older cases involving multiple victims using DNA from incarcerated individuals.

2023 3rd Quarter - Crimes Against Property

In the Third Quarter of 2023, Crimes Against Property decreased 0.2% overall with 8,788 offenses reported compared to 8,803 offenses reported in the Third Quarter of 2022. In the Third Quarter, there was an increase in Motor Vehicle Theft. There were decreases in Arson, Counterfeiting/Forgery, Fraud, and Stolen Property Offenses.



Burglary/Breaking and Entering


In the Third Quarter of 2023, burglary/breaking and entering offenses decreased 7.7% with 861 offenses reported compared to 933 offenses reported in the Third Quarter of 2022.

Larceny/Theft Offenses

In the Third Quarter of 2023, the total number of Larceny/Theft offenses decreased 7.8% with 4,464 offenses reported compared to 4,842 offenses reported in the Third Quarter of 2022. There were increases in Pocket-picking & Purse-snatching and Shoplifting and decreases in Thefts from Motor Vehicles and Thefts of Motor Vehicle parts and Accessories compared to the Third Quarter of 2022.



Robbery Offenses

In the Third Quarter of 2023, robbery offenses **increased 4.3%** compared to the Third Quarter of 2022.


Robbery detectives utilize resources within the FBI Task Force, U.S. Marshal Service, Intel Unit, Crime Stoppers, and the Crime Analysis Unit to develop leads. 2023 3rd Quarter - Crimes Against Society

Crimes Against Society offenses are a reflection of the department's mitigation and resolution strategies. Each violation is counted as one offense. In the Third Quarter of 2023, Crimes Against Society decreased 3% overall with 1,151 offenses compared to 1,187 offenses reported in the Third Quarter of 2022. Pornography/obscene material increased 49.1% with 85 offenses compared to 57 offenses reported in the Third Quarter of 2022. Weapons Law violations decreased 20.6% with 255 offenses compared to 321 in the Third Quarter of 2022.




2023 3rd Quarter - Gang Unit Report

In the Third Quarter of 2023, the number of cases assigned to the Gang Unit decreased 16.7% with 80 cases assigned compared to 96 cases assigned in the Third Quarter of 2022. Assaults increased 5.3%. Drug/Narcotics violations decreased 62.5% and Weapons Law Violations decreased 55% compared to the Third Quarter of 2022.




Comparison of Citywide Gang-Related Offenses, 2021 - 2023




Gang-Related Offenses by Patrol Division 3rd Quarter 2023 vs 3rd Quarter 2022




Fort Worth City Council District Map






Major Cities Comparison

Homicide, January - June 2023




Rape, January - June 2023



Department Initiatives

Fort Worth PD Secures DNA Grant Funding

The Fort Worth Police Department received \$787,330 out of \$2,095,653 in grants awarded to Fort Worth Area Agencies from the Department of Justice's Capacity Enhancement for Backlog Reduction Program to reduce DNA and rape kit backlogs. The program is part of the 2004 Debbie Smith Act to provide local and state crime laboratories with resources to end the backlog of untested DNA evidence from unsolved crimes, analyze DNA samples, and increase the capacity to process DNA to guard against future backlogs.



Vehicle Storage Facility Grand Opening

The Fort Worth Police Department held a grand opening of the new Vehicle Storage Facility at Bob Bolen Public Safety Complex on September 28. Mayor Mattie Parker and councilmembers attended the event. The \$1.9 million-dollar project was funded by the Crime Control and Prevention District and was designed by Elements of Architecture Inc. and constructed by West Fork Construction LLC. The 5,576 square foot facility is a dedicated storage space for a variety of specialized vehicles, enhancing the capacity for equipment storage and maintenance.





Women in Law Enforcement Conference

Approximately 500 women police officers representing more than 121 law enforcement agencies around the country attended the Women in Law Enforcement Conference at the Bob Bolen Public Safety Complex. The Fort Worth Police Department hosted the event in September. The officers had classroom, hands on, shooting, and scenario training.



World Police and Fire Games

FWPD Bike Patrol Officers Kynrick Koralewski, Marcus Mendoza, and Ruben Silva (pictured left to right) competed in the World Police and Fire games July 29-August 4 in Winnipeg, Canada. Officer Mendoza received silver medals in the 40-49 Men's Street Criterium and the Men's team trial. The World Police and Fire Games is an Olympic-style competition with more than 8,500 athletes representing law enforcement, firefighters, and police officers from more than 50 countries across the world competing in more than 60 unique sports.



Lone Star Elementary Patriot Parade

Fort Worth Police were among several first responder agencies that participated in the Lone Star Elementary School Patriot Parade on September 8, 2023 in north Fort Worth. The event commemorates the heroism of First Responders for their actions on September 11, 2001. The students shook hands, gave fist bumps, and thank you cards to officers in appreciation of their service.
