1	SEC. 2. REQUIRED TRAINING ON CONSTITUTION OF THE
2	UNITED STATES FOR COMMISSIONED OFFI-
3	CERS OF THE ARMED FORCES.
4	Not later than 180 days after the date of the enact-
5	ment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense shall ensure
6	that all newly commissioned officers of the Armed Forces
7	receive training on the Constitution of the United States
8	prior to reporting to their first operational assignment.
9	The training shall include—
10	(1) education on the centrality of the Constitu-
11	tion to the commitment officers make to serve in the
12	Armed Forces;
13	(2) emphasis on the loyalty of officers to the
14	Constitution; and
15	(3) instruction on certain aspects of the Con-
16	stitution relevant to military service, including—
17	(A) civil-military relations;
18	(B) separation of powers; and
19	(C) restrictions on the domestic use of
20	military force.
