RE: Dallas Police Department General Order 315.04 on Immigration

Mr. Friedrichs:

This letter is in response to your April 16, 2026, letter to Mayor Eric Johnson regarding Dallas Police Department's (DPD) General Order 315.04 on immigration and DPD's cooperation with federal immigration authorities. The City of Dallas remains committed to maintaining eligibility for grant funding and strong coordination with state partners. Although your letter does not specifically identify the portions of General Order 315.04 you find problematic, DPD has completed a review of General Order 315.04 and has revised certain provisions in the general order to further clarify DPD's continued compliance with state law regarding immigration enforcement.

The revised DPD General Order 315.04 reaffirms and clarifies that DPD officers are not prohibited from any of the following:

- inquiring about immigration status of an individual who is lawfully detained or arrested;
- cooperating with and assisting federal agencies or federal immigration officers as reasonable or necessary; or
- sharing information regarding immigration status with federal authorities.

General Order 315.04 aligns with state law while continuing effective policing, building and maintaining the community's trust, and retaining officer discretion that is clearly defined within legal parameters.
